## Notice of Finding of No Significant Effect On The Environment

To All Interested Agencies, Groups and Persons:

The above-named city proposes to request the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to release Federal funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383) to be used for the following project:

Acquisition of Elderly Housing Site  
Downtown General Area  
Mt. Vernon (Rockcastle Co.) Kentucky

\$26,000

It has been determined that such request for release of funds will not constitute an action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment and, accordingly, the above-named city has decided not to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (PL 91-190).

The reasons for such decision not to prepare such Statement are as follows:

- Only temporary and minimal adverse effects will occur as the result of construction activities such as increased noise and dust levels during daily working hours.
- The long-term position environmental effects far outweigh the short term adverse effects listed above. The positive effects include: ...provision of a site for new and adequate housing for low and moderate income families and elderly persons...a more productive use for a conveniently located site.
- Only negligible effect will be

experienced by the community's facilities and services.

An Environmental Review Record respecting the within project has been made by the above-named city which documents the environmental review of the project and more fully sets forth the reasons why such Statement is not required. This Environmental Review Record is on file at the above address and is available for public examination and copying, upon request, at the City Hall, City Clerk's office between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

No further environmental review of such project is proposed to be conducted, prior to the request for release of Federal funds.

All interested agencies, groups and persons disagreeing with this decision are invited to submit written comments for consideration by the city to the Mayor at City Hall. Such written comments should be received at the address specified on or before December 5, 1977. All such comments so received will be considered and the city will not request the release of Federal funds or take any administrative action on the within project prior to the date specified in the preceding sentence.

Herb Vesco of Eastern Kentucky University wants to make Kentuckians aware of student financial assistance since he's been appointed chairman of a special committee to observe Financial Aid Awareness Week by the president of the Kentucky Association of Student Financial Assistance Administrators. Vesco, director of the program at Eastern, said the special week will be held January 22-28.

Eastern Kentucky University's Symphony Orchestra will present its fall concert Monday (Nov. 21) at 8:30 p.m. in

Hiram Brock Auditorium, with pianist David Wehr as guest soloist. The public is invited to attend without admission charge.

Conductor Earl Thomas said the program will also feature the women's voices of the EKV Singers in the Sirens portion of Debussy's "Three Nocturnes." The Singers are directed by David Wehr Sr.

Soloist Wehr, a graduate senior at the University of Kansas from Richmond, will perform Tschalkovsky's Piano Concerto No. 1. Young piano players are invited to attend a dress rehearsal of this selection Sunday at 5:30 p.m. in Gifford Theatre.

Computerized library cataloging was the subject of a recent conference in Chicago attended by four catalogers from Eastern Kentucky University's John Grant Crabbe Library: George Crabb, Michi Kwak, Miko Pattie, and Carol Thomas. The conference, sponsored by the Associated College of the Midwest, was attended by about 400 representatives from colleges and universities.
